Glenn was brought up in a Christian home and taught to love and serve the Lord at an early age. Although he made a profession of faith at the age of four, it was not until 1999 that he truly accepted the Lord as his personal Savior while at a Christian Camp. During that same week, Glenn surrendered his life to full-time service for the Lord, knowing that God was working in his heart to surrender to His call to preach. Instead of surrendering immediately to the Lord's moving on his heart, Glenn began to fight the Lord's convicting work. It was not that he did not want to preach, but he feared that others would think he wanted to preach only because his father and grandfather were preachers. After fighting the Lord for an entire year, Glenn realized it was more important to please the Lord than to be concerned about what others would think of him. At the age of thirteen Glenn surrendered his life to preach the Gospel.

Growing up in a pastor's home afforded Glenn many opportunities to help his father and serve the Lord. His experience included; soul winning, youth work, camp work, music, and preaching. From

the time he surrendered to preach the Lord has given him many opportunities to deliver the messages that God had laid on his heart.

During his time at Ambassador Baptist College, Glenn traveled for the school on weekends in several quartets as well as in the college ensemble. During the summer following his sophomore year, Glenn traveled with Missionary Dr. Ron White to the countries of Romania, China, Japan, and the Philippines. After Glenn completed his junior year he traveled with Evangelist Richard Harper and visited 4 states and Canada. Throughout all of these travels, he has been able to preach and minister in music. Following graduation Glenn will be traveling for Ambassador through most of the summer leading a quartet and preaching in almost every service.
